This involves identifying opportunities to digitize financial processes and implementing digital tools and technologies to improve efficiency and accuracy. CFOs now assume responsibility for ensuring that the finance function is equipped with the necessary digital skills and capabilities. This includes identifying areas where the finance team

may need additional training in digital tools and technologies and investing in the development of these skills. According to a 2023 Gartner Survey of the Top 10 Priorities of CFOs, 83% of CFOs are significantly involved or leading transformation activities.

Sustainable finance is moving up the agenda, with conferences addressing topics like adaptation finance and the role of financial institutions in achieving net-zero emissions. Impact Investing i.e. investments made with the explicit intention of generating measurable social and environmental impact alongside a financial return, is widening Gamut. As organizations contend with perceptions of “greenwashing”, or even “greenhushing”, front-line accountability often resides with the CFO. In fact, data shows that more than two-thirds of CFOs are now responsible for their company’s ESG compliance and reporting.

In GRC Front (Governance, Risk & Compliance) front, CFO can champion strong governance, lead Enterprise risk management, anchor regulatory compliance & infuse GRC into strategy. Modern CFOs are co-pilot in business transformation. Modern CFOs Drive tech adoption for smarter compliance, Use risk and compliance data to fuel innovation and Champion cross-team collaboration.
